Notice of Mandatory Water Restrictions

Due to ongoing drought conditions, West Park Municipal Utility District (WP MUD) has implemented Stage 2 of its Drought Contingency Plan. Effective immediately, the following mandatory water use restrictions are in place:

1. Customers shall be permitted to irrigate landscaped areas (using hose-end sprinklers or automatic irrigation systems), wash vehicles, and fill pools, fountains, etc. solely between the hours of 8:00 p.m. on the designated watering day and 6:00 a.m. on the following day as follows:
 - Customers with even numbered addresses: even numbered dates
 - Customers with odd-numbered addresses: odd numbered dates
 - Customers responsible for watering esplanades, sports fields or other common areas: even numbered dates
2. Vehicle washing shall be done with a hand-held bucket or hand-held hose equipped with a positive shutoff nozzle.
3. Operation of any ornamental fountain or pond for aesthetic or scenic purposes is prohibited except where necessary to support aquatic life or where such fountains or ponds are equipped with a recirculation system.
4. All restaurants are prohibited from serving water to patrons except when requested.
5. Customers are required to repair all detectible water leaks within 72 hours of discovery.
6. Violations of these Restrictions may result in a fine of not less than \$50.00 and not more than \$1000.00 per offense, and repeat offenses may result in termination of service, all pursuant to the Drought Contingency Plan for WP MUD.
